ADVANCED REVISION COURSE for students taking higher surgical examinations.

This is limited to senior students who are about to take the Final examination. In addition to a series of lecture/discussions at the appropriate level in the Specialty and in related branches of general surgery, there are a number of clinical and viva voce sessions and arrangements for the setting and correction of test papers.

A copy of the syllabus giving full information about the teaching and research facilities provided by the Institute, and a detailed programme of any of the courses and of the short courses on specific aspects which are arranged from time to time can be obtained from the Secretary-Administrator.

The clinical practice can be joined at any time by individual arrangement with the Dean. This includes daily practical teaching in the clinics and operating theatres and ward-rounds and special demonstrations weekly.

Demonstrations of clinical cases, open clinical lectures and clinical pathological conferences are held at regular intervals throughout the year, and are open without fee to all trainees in the Specialty. A list giving dates and times is obtainable in the Secretary-Administrator's office.









INSTRUMENTS FOR MIDDLE EAR SURGERY

Rosen's Slotted Specula, as used by Mr. Angell James; 4 sizes, 4, 5, 6 and 7 mm.


