In Memoriam ~ Joyce Rutherford Malm

Joyce Rutherford Malm died December 12, 2002 in Ann Arbor, Michigan. She was born June 6, 1930 in Los Angeles, California, the daughter of Dwight and Mildred Rutherford. On April 24, 1954, she married William P. Malm, now an internationally known ethnomusicologist. William Malm served on the faculty of the University of Michigan from 1960 until 1994.

Joyce Malm received an undergraduate degree in dance from the University of California, Los Angeles and a masters degree from the University of Michigan. She taught modern dance at Alhambra High School in California and dance history at the University of Michigan. Her research interest was in the

Japan. She performed and studied Japanese dance in Tokyo and is the author of several articles and reviews on the subject, especially "The Legacy to Nihon Buyō," published in *Dance Research Journal* 9, no.2. She was President of the Congress on Research in Dance from 1980 through 1982.

Malm is survived by her husband, three daughters, and a granddaughter. She was also a talented visual artist whose works were exhibited at galleries in Hawaii and Ann Arbor.
