EDITORIAL NOTE

Coyet's letters are here numbered in Arabic, Bonde's in Roman, numerals. Foreign proper names and place names, after their first occurrence, are given their modern spelling, 'Ewre Köningl. Maij', 'Es. Kl. M:tt', are shortened to 'Y.M.', and some submissive and ceremonious adjectives and adverbs are occasionally omitted as superfluous.

Dating in the originals (which is here preserved) is Old Style; but New Style is standard for the de Witt-Nieupoort correspondence.

In BL Add. MS 38100 the letters of Coyet, in chronological order, are in fos. 58–183; those of Bonde, likewise in chronological order, are in fos. 221–412, except that where there is a gap in the RA *Anglica* series, or where a despatch has not been decyphered, the transcriber has supplied the want from Bonde's *Register*: these letters are in fos. 185–219. In the translation which follows, they are all ordered in one chronological series.
