# INVOLVEMENT LOAD HYPOTHESIS PLUS: CREATING AN IMPROVED PREDICTIVE MODEL OF INCIDENTAL VOCABULARY LEARNING – ERRATUM

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In the original publication of this article (Yanagisawa & Webb, 2021), the presentation of the second incidental vocabulary learning (IVL) formula, the incidental vocabulary learning formula of activities for retention, contained an incorrect number. The number "15.3" in the second-to-last line of the formula should be "11.5." The full correct formula appears below:

The incidental vocabulary learning formula of activities for retention

- = [Need (absent : 0 or present : 1)  $\times$  13.8]
  - + [Search (0 or 1)  $\times$  -5.1]
  - + [Evaluation (0 or 1)  $\times$  9.1]
  - + [Sentence-level varied use  $(0 \text{ or } 1) \times 11.5$ ]
  - + [Composition-level varied use  $(0 \text{ or } 1) \times 21.0$ ]
