BIENNIAL PRIZE FOR YOUNG SCHOLARS WORKING ON EUROPEAN BANKING HISTORY

The European Association for Banking History e.V. will award a prize to an individual scholar, or a team of at most three scholars, working on either an institutional, economic or social aspect of the history of European banking, or a biography of a European banker or banker's dynasty. Studies should meet academic requirements, should be unpublished and consist of 80,000 to 120,000 words. The applicants should not be over 35 when submitting their manuscripts. The text will be accepted in any European language, but will have to be accompanied by an abstract of 3,000 words/10 pages in English.
