## a) PROGRAMME FOR THE COLLOQUIUM 1961

The Swedish Actuarial Society is arranging a Colloquium to be held at Persborg, Rättvik, from 14th to 18th June 1961 and has extended an invitation to Astin members to take part. The programme will be as follows:

General Aspects of Non-Life Actuarial Research by the President of the Swedisch Actuarial Society, Prof. Harald Cramér.

Discussions, which will be held in English and French, will be based on the following three subjects:

Modern Theory of risk:

Fundamental Mathematics and Applications.

Distribution of the amount of one claim.

Problems in Motor-Insurance-Rating, Bonus, Estimation of Claim Reserves, Risk Reserve, Reinsurance.

Consideration with regard to unlimited liability will be appreciated.

Members of Astin who wish to take part are requested to send their applications, together with an advance payment of Sw. Kr. 100, to the Swedish member of the Astin committee:

The Colloquium is to take place in the countryside in picturesque Dalecarlia and as accommodation is necessarily limited, applications must be sent in not later than 1st March 1961. Facilities for ladies of members during the working period of the Colloquium are of necessity also limited.

When communicating with Mr. Philipson members are requested to state if they intend to submit communications for discussion. So that those taking part in the Colloquium can have the opportunity of studying the papers before discussion they should be in his hands not later than 1st May 1961. It is suggested that the communications, which can be in English or French, should not exceed 2000 words and 125 copies of size A 4 or quarto should be forwarded to Mr. Philipson.
