Fourth Meeting, 14th February 1902.

Dr THIRD, Vice-President, in the Chair.

Discussion on proposed improvements in the Teaching of Elementary Mathematics.

Dr Carslaw introduced the subject by reviewing the present position of Elementary Mathematical Teaching, making special reference to the recent discussion by Professor Perry and others before the Mathematical Section of the British Association. Most of the other members present also expressed their views. It was finally agreed to appoint a Committee, consisting of Mr Alison, Dr Carslaw, Mr W. J. Macdonald, Dr Mackay, Dr Morgan, Mr Tweedie, Mr M'Intosh (*Convener*), to draw up, and submit to the next meeting, a set of resolutions indicating certain changes in connection with the Teaching of Elementary Mathematics.
