Members of the Spanish Clay Group (Grupo Español de Minerales de la Arcilla; GEMA) met at the Department of Crystallography and Mineralogy of the University of Madrid, the 13th and 14th of June, 1969.

At the meeting of the 13th, a representative of every Spanish Center working on Clay Minerals, gave short communications about their lines of research. On the 14th, the general assembly of the GEMA met. The following accords were taken:

1. The Spanish Clay Group (GEMA) organized in 1959, with Dr. Alexandre as President and Dr. Martin-Vivaldi as Secretary, will become an independent Society (Sociedad Espanola de Arcillas: SEA).
2. The statutes and bylaws were under discussion and after several modifications, they were approved.
