Information for Contributors

The Glasgow Mathematical Journal invites submission of papers in any branch of Pure or Applied Mathematics. Contributions from all parts of the world are welcomed and given careful consideration.

Manuscripts, preferably typed, should be prepared so as to conform with the practice in current issues of the Journal, especially with regard to references, tables and figures.

References should be placed at the end of the paper, arranged and numbered in alphabetical order. In the text, reference numbers should be enclosed in square brackets and underlined, to distinguish them from formula numbers, which should be quoted in round brackets. The following particulars should be given, in the order indicated:

for references to books—author, title, edition, publisher, year of publication, page reference;

for references to articles in periodicals—author, title of article, short title of periodical, series no. (if any), volume no., year, pagination.

Text figures must be suitable for photographic reproduction and supplied separate from the text but allocated clearly to sections of the text.

Contributors receive a set of proofs, together with an order form for offprints. Fifty offprints are supplied free; additional copies will be supplied at cost if ordered prior to publication. Excessive corrections may be charged to the contributor.
