SHEA National Meeting a Hit

Our first official, national scientific meeting, "Hospital Epidemiology: New Challenges and Controversies," was held March 10-12 in Baltimore. The meeting, cosponsored by SHEA and the *Journal*, was a resounding educational and scientific success. Clearly, two "thumbs up" were accorded by the delighted audience.

Meeting attendance topped the 300 mark, with participants coming from as far away as the United Kingdom, India, and Japan. Despite the balmy early spring weather and the sightseeing-packed venue of Baltimore's charming Inner Harbor area, our meeting hall was full for every session—up through the final presentations Sunday morning. Such a level of interest in a scientific meeting is probably unparalleled in recent history.

The 30-person faculty provided information, data, and opinions that were virtually up-to-the-minute. The postpresentation question-and-answer sessions were especially lively, and the extremely well-informed audience members never seemed to tire of collegially quizzing the speakers and sharing their own insights and new information.

The Poster Session included 22 abstracts and posters, which were well displayed and heavily viewed.

The triumphant Program Committee (Ms. Bolyard and Drs. Garibaldi, Hierholzer, Schaffner, Townsend, and Wenzel) and the session chairmen plan to publish a summary of the meeting's scientific sessions in the *Journal* later this year.

The National Meeting Evaluation Committee (Drs. Schaberg, Mayhall, Garibaldi, and Townsend) will be evaluating the written comments of the meeting attendees and will make recommendations regarding subsequent national scientific offerings by the Society.

Nominating Committee Appointed

A nominating committee (Dr. Murray Batt, chair, with members Drs. Frank Check, Jr.; Kenrad Nelson; Frank Rhame; and Michael Tapper) has been appointed by Dr. Hierholzer to prepare a slate for the fall SHEA elections.
