## SHEA Draft Guidelines for Infection Control in Hospital Personnel

SHEA members whose current e-mail addresses are not on file with SHEA headquarters and who have not recently visited the SHEA web address (http://www.medscape.com/SHEA) may not know that, on September 8, draft guidelines for infection control in healthcare personnel were published in the Federal Register. Although the comment period closed on October 17,

the draft document still may be obtained from the CDC's Hospital Infection Program link to the SHEA web site. The final version of this document, to be published by the CDC after all written comments are reviewed and evaluated, is expected in early 1998. It will replace the current (1983) CDC Guidelines for Infection Control in Hospital Personnel.
