BOOKS.

BRAUN, M. (1905.) *The Animal Parasites of Man, A Handbook for Students and Medical Men.* 3rd edition, enlarged and improved. London: John Bale, Sons and Danielsson, Ltd. 453 pp. 294 illustrations in text. 26 × 17cm. Cloth, price 21/- net.

This standard work, translated by P. Falcke, and brought up to date by L. W. Sambon and F. V. Theobald, will certainly be welcome to English readers. Parts are not above criticism, thus on p. 360 *et seq.* there are numerous typographical errors: Haemapsyllis, Haemaphysalis (for Haemaphysalis), Ornithodoros (for Ornithodoros), Escatocephalus (for Eschatocephalus), Phauloixodes (for Phauloixodes), Rhicocephalus, also on p. 88 Rhipocephalus (for Rhipicephalus), Oplitodon (for Opisthodon), etc. There are much better figures of Anopheles and its structure than those of Grassi's, and the figures of ticks from Pagenstecher (1861!) do not belong in a work claiming to be brought up to date although they are of historical interest. The same may be said of Ménégnin's wretched figure of Argas persicus. These blemishes do not however seriously detract from the value of the work.

GOULD, G. M. (1905.) *Biographic Clinics.* Vol. III. *Influence of Visual Function upon Health.* Philadelphia: P. Blakiston's Son and Co. 516 pp., 31 figs. 20 × 14 cm. Cloth.

The third volume of this interesting series of essays will be welcomed by those who have read the previous volumes by this author.

MENSE, C. (1905.) *Handbuch der Tropenkrankheiten.* Vol. II. 472 pp. 18 plates. 126 figs. Leipzig: Verlag von Johann Ambr. Barth. 25 × 16 cm. Price, paper 16 Marks, bound 17.50 Marks.

This work, of which this is the second volume, is one which will prove indispensable to students of tropical medicine. The present volume includes chapters on Aphthae tropicae by A. van der Scheer; Mosquitoes by A. Eysell; Dengue by C. L. van der Burg; Yellow Fever by J. Carroll; Beri-beri by E. Bälz and K. Miura; Leprosy by G. Sticker; Dysentery (bacterial) by R. Ruge; Cholera by P. Krause and Th. Rumpf; Malta Fever by P. W. Bassett-Smith; Typhoid Fever by L. Martin; Plague by R. Pösch; the Acute Exanthemata by A. Plehn.

MOORE, V. A. (1905.) *Laboratory directions for beginners in Bacteriology. An Introduction to Practical Bacteriology for Students and Practitioners of Comparative and of Human Medicine.* 3rd ed. enlarged and revised. 151 pp. 6 figs. 2 plates. London: Ginn and Company. 19 × 13 cm. Cloth.

A useful little work intended for the purposes indicated in the title.

NEUMANN, L. G. (1905.) *A Treatise on the Parasites and Parasitic Diseases of the Domesticated Animals*. Translated by G. Fleming. 2nd ed. revised and edited by J. Maqueen. 900 pp., 365 illustrations. London: Ballière, Tindall and Cox. 22 × 15 cm. Price 21/- net. Cloth.

The editor and publishers may well be congratulated on the excellent appearance presented by this very useful and standard work.

NOTTER, J. L., and FIRTH, R. H. (1905.) *Hygiene*. 6th ed., 491 pp., 99 figs. London: Longmans, Green and Co. 19 × 13 cm. Price 4/6. Cloth.

The fact that this work has reached its 6th edition, the first having appeared in 1894, sufficiently indicates its usefulness. The present edition has been completely revised and it contains a considerable amount of new matter relating to the examination of water, food, and infective diseases.
