- Epidemiology, genetics and basic research.

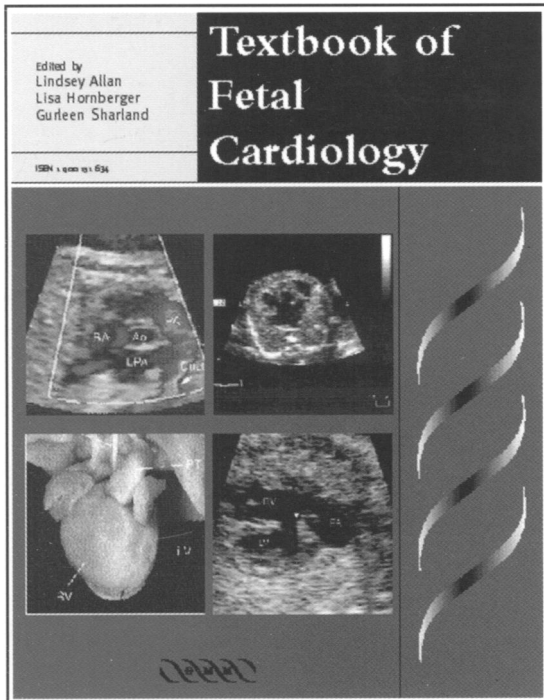
**Registration Fee:**
