The editors are pleased to receive manuscripts for publication in *Africa*. An outline of submission requirements is below; please refer to the journal's website at www.eupjournals.com for detailed submission instructions.

Manuscripts are considered for publication on the understanding that they have neither been published nor submitted for publication elsewhere. Contributors must inform the editors if the work has been made public in another form or language.

Manuscripts should not normally exceed 8,000 words (excluding bibliography and notes). Email attachment alone will be accepted so long as orthographic conventions are made clear wherever confusion about special symbols might arise. Files should be in Word for PC.

The editors reserve the right to make editorial revisions, but will not make major changes without the author's approval.
