- 400 *Trombidium akamushi* Brumpt, 1910 (Acarina): proposed validation.
- 1844 *Homo lar* Linnaeus, 1771: interpretation of (Mammalia: HYLOBATIDAE).
- 1877 *Galaxias platei* Steindachner, 1898 (Pisces): proposal to give precedence over *Galaxias delfini* Philippi, 1895.
- 2115 *Glyphipterix* Hübner [1825] (Lepidoptera, GLYPHIPTERYGIDAE): proposed designation of a type-species.
- 2130 *Stethaspis* Hope, 1837 (Coleoptera): proposed designation of a type-species.
