The author greatly regrets that her criticism (on p. 347, column 1, line 19) of figures 6 and 7 on plate 12 of Mudd, Heinmets and Anderson's paper, 'The pneumococcal capsular swelling reaction, studied with the aid of the electron microscope' (*J. Exp. Med.* 1943, 78, p. 327), has been taken to refer also to the other figures in this paper, which are excellent and distinct.

Unfortunately her same criticism published in *Schweiz. Zeitsch. Path. Bact.* (1948, 11, 336) has been similarly misinterpreted.
