


Dan McKenzie's NASAL FORCEPS.

These are a modification of Luc's Nasal Forceps with the handles bent at an angle which permits the operator to keep the blades always in view. They have been found very useful in ordinary nasal work and in submucous resection. The bars on the handles provide additional holds for the fingers and add to the handiness of the

instrument "Emandem" **Improved** Metallic Filament Lamp. (Registered Design.) Gives a light of intense brilliancy (40-50 c.p.), almost equal to the Nernst Lamp, which is now unobtainable. Can be recommended to those who require a good light for special work or for general surgery.


