1. All contributions and books for review should be sent to the editor, Professor H. D. Lewis, King's College, Strand, London, W.C.2.
2. Contributions should normally be in English and should preferably be type-written (double-spaced on quarto paper). Contributors should keep a copy themselves for use when correcting proofs.
3. Submission of an article is taken to imply that it has not previously been published, or is not being considered for publication elsewhere.
4. All contributors receive 50 free separates.

Many of the articles in the present number of *Religious Studies* converge on similar themes. It was thought that readers would like to have these together in this way. But there is no general policy of selecting special themes for each number. The breadth of interest of the first numbers will be continued and the next number will include the Leo Robertson Lecture on Mysticism by J. N. Findlay, together with articles by Mircea Eliade, D. M. Mackinnon, J. K. Feibleman, J. E. Barnhart and others. There will also be several reviews and book discussions hitherto held over through lack of space.
