### REPORT OF THE ESSAY CONTEST OF THE INSTITUTE FOR THE UNITY OF SCIENCE

The Institute for the Unity of Science is pleased to announce the winners in the Prize Essay Contest which it sponsored on the theme "The Divorce Between Science and Philosophy."

The committee of judges has not found it possible to award a first prize. Two second prizes of \$150 each were awarded to Dr. George Kline, Orangeburg, New York, and Mr. Eugene Luschei of Lincoln, Nebraska.
