

## eJobs Placement Service

**The APSA Annual Meeting Placement Interview Service helps employers and candidates find out who's available for interviews at the Annual Meeting and helps them contact each other before the meeting to set up interviews. At the Annual Meeting, APSA provides space and facilities for conducting interviews.**

### Using the Annual Meeting Placement Service

---

*Candidates* post resumes on [www.apsanet.org](http://www.apsanet.org) prior to the meeting and indicate the dates they will be available for interviews during the meeting. Employers will use this information to identify potential interviewees. This service and the free resume posting is offered exclusively to APSA members. Non-members: join APSA now to participate.

*Employers* post job listings on [www.apsanet.org](http://www.apsanet.org) and indicate the dates they will be conducting interviews during the meeting. APSA Departmental Service Program members can post job listings and participate in the Placement Service free of charge. Non-member employers are charged a placement service fee in addition to the posting fee for each job listing. Once an employer indicates the days that they will conduct interviews at the Annual Meeting, APSA reserves table space for interviews. **Table space is limited and availability guaranteed for those who reserve by posting in advance of the meeting.**

### Connecting at the Meeting

---

The APSA eJobs system identifies employers who will conduct interviews and candidates who will be available for interviews during the meeting. Employers should use this information to schedule interviews before the meeting.

### Visited eJobs Lately?

---

APSA's eJobs is a year-round online resource for political science employers and job candidates. It contains the most comprehensive online listing of political science jobs, is updated daily with new job listings and candidate resumes, and is searchable by field of interest, name of employer/candidate, region, keyword, position, salary, type of institution, and most recent postings.




