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INSTRUCTIONS FOR CONTRIBUTORS

1. Submissions must:
 - a. be the original work of the author;
 - b. not be under consideration for publication elsewhere;
 - c. not have been published before, even in part, in print or electronically.
2. Submissions should be made online at <http://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/hj>

You will need to create an account if you do not have one. (If you are unsure if you have an account, or have forgotten your password, use the password help function.) Please contact the part-time office at hj@hist.cam.ac.uk if you have any questions about the procedure, or wish to make a submission by another means.

3. Aside from the main text, you will need to provide with your submission:
 - a. an abstract of not more than 200 words;
 - b. a single title which clarifies the subject matter of your paper, and which is no more than 20 words long. Colons and sub-titles are only allowed at the discretion of the co-editors;
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10. While much of the content we publish rests on original research and specialist knowledge, contributions should be accessible and stimulating to the non-specialist. It is vital that you provide sufficient historiographical context and make clear the wider significance of your submission.

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
