(1) In consideration of the publication of this Article, the Author hereby transfers copyright for this Article to the ASL, with the following stipulations:
(2) The ASL hereby grants to the Author the non-exclusive right to reproduce the Article, to create derivative works based upon the Article, and to distribute and display the Article and any such derivative work by any means and in any media, provided the provisions of clause (3) below are met. The Author may sub-license any publisher or other third party to exercise those rights.
(3) Whenever the Author reproduces or distributes the Article, the Author (a) will ensure that credit for publication in The Bulletin of Symbolic Logic is explicitly stated (with bibliographic details) and (b) will ensure that the fact of copyright ownership by the ASL is explicitly stated.
(4) The Author warrants that the Author is the sole author of the Article and has the complete and unencumbered right to make the grants made herein to the ASL. Except as explicitly noted below, the Author warrants that the Article is an original work not published elsewhere in whole or in part, except in abstract form. If portions have been previously published, the Author will submit a copy of the permission release(s) and the text of credit lines for the prior publication(s) with the manuscript. The Author also warrants that the Article does not libel anyone or infringe anyone's copyright. The Author acknowledges that the ASL is relying on these warranties in agreeing to publish the Article, and the Author takes full responsibility for their accuracy.
