

Shakespeare, William. A Midsommer nights dreame. London: [by Richard Bradock] for Thomas Fisher, 1600. Folger STC 22302

A Midsummer Night's Dream was first printed in 1600 as a quarto (Q1). In 1619, a new quarto of the play was published (Q2) based on Q1 but with some additional stage directions and some small corrections to the text. That text, in turn, was the basis for the 1623 First Folio (F1) with, again, some minor changes, including the substitution of Egeus for Philostrate in the final scene of the play.
