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An "extra-illustrated" work is a printed text that has been embellished by the addition of illustrations not planned as part of the original printing. Thomas Willement (1786-1871) added a number of watercolors to this copy of *Richard II* in 1857, including this coat of arms opposite the title page. The book had been given to Willement by Charles Kean, its editor.

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
