

The Painfull Adventures of Pericles, Prince of Tyre is Lawrence Twine's prose novel that translates the tale of Apollonius of Tyre from John Gower's Confessio Amantis from Middle to late 16th-century English. The 1608 edition of the novel was one of Shakespeare's sources for Pericles, Prince of Tyre. This copy, printed in 1857, is a facsimile of the 1608 version.
