This engraving illustrates Act 3, Scene 1 of *Titus Andronicus*. In this scene, Titus attempts to save the lives of his sons Martius and Quintus by permitting Aaron to cut off one of his hands. Ultimately, however, Titus' sacrifice fails to save his sons, whose heads and hands are brought to him later in the scene.
