

## Shakespeare, William. King Richard III. London: J.M. Dent & Sons, 1935. Folger 266587.

Though Margaret of Anjou appears as a powerful queen in Shakespeare's Henry VI plays, her presence in King Richard III is as a shadow of her former self, a monarch without a crown who curses her enemies and celebrates their downfall. Her character is often cut from productions of King Richard III. This script shows Laurence Olivier strikes through all of Margaret's lines in Act 1, Scene 3.

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
