This crown was worn by American actress Marie Drofnah in a late 19th- or early 20th-century production of *The Winter's Tale*. Before she married actor Charles B. Hanford in 1885, Drofnah was a Washington, D.C. schoolteacher named Mariella T. Bear. After their marriage, she joined her husband on stage, flipping his surname for her stage name.
