The work of the colorfully named artist Augustus Leopold Egg is the source for this engraving of the shepherdess Mopsa, a minor character in *The Winter's Tale*. She appears only in Act 4, Scene 4, alongside Dorcas, another shepherdess, with whom she competes for the affections of the Shepherd's Son, Perdita's adopted brother.
