Eduard von Grützner is perhaps best known today for his paintings of monks producing and enjoying beer; Falstaff, however, was another classic subject of his. von Grützner, who lived in Germany in the late 19th and early 20th centuries, also portrayed Falstaff onstage. It's unknown whether von Grützner used himself as a model for this engraving or other depictions of the character.
