The Folger Shakespeare Library collection includes many sets of costume sketches from productions of Shakespeare's works; often one can see those designs in action with complementary photographs in the collection. It's more rare for fabric samples -- let alone the garment itself -- to accompany the designs. However, small swatches appear beside John Seymour Lucas' nineteenth-century designs for an undated production of *The Tragedy of King Lear*, including these red and green pieces that offer a vibrant glimpse of the Fool's costume.
