

McKie, Elizabeth. Shakespearian Atlas (manuscript work). United States, 1934. pp. 35-36. Folger W.b.638

In 1934, Elizabeth McKie designed this atlas of locations in Shakespeare's plays after her father, a professor of literature, noted that he had never seen a work that visualized all the plays' settings. Elizabeth mapped out fictional locations ("Petruchio's country house") in addition to real ones like Mantua and Verona, where Shakespeare sets *Romeo and Juliet*.
