For full consideration, interdisciplinary papers must demonstrate either new and interesting research results in astronomy or astrophysics; or application of astronomy techniques to achieve such results in a different field, which is likely to be of interest to PASA's readership.

The PASA Editorial Board reserves the right to not consider submissions for which, in its judgement, the Board does not have sufficient professional expertise to make informed editorial decisions. In such cases, we encourage authors to consider submitting their work to more appropriate (e.g. interdisciplinary) journals.
