# Expand access to Cambridge University Press content with WorldCat Discovery

## Maximize your content investments

WorldCat Discovery lets your users to discover and access Cambridge University content along with more than three billion electronic, digital, and physical resources in libraries around the world through a single search of WorldCat and a central index of more than 3,100 e-content collections.



Thanks to the Cambridge University Press/OCLC partnership, your users can search authoritative Cambridge University Press databases through WorldCat Discovery. Our partnership increases your users' visibility into your subscribed Cambridge University Press databases, and it enables links to available full text through either the WorldCat knowledge base or a knowledge base already in place at your library.

## Easily select your Cambridge University Press databases

Selecting content in WorldCat Discovery is easy and intuitive. Follow these simple steps to set up access to your Cambridge University Press subscription content through WorldCat Discovery. For more detailed instructions and screen shots, see the following section.

1. **Review your searchable databases.** Go to the [OCLC Service Configuration](https://oclc.org/oclc-service-configuration) site at [oclc.org/config](https://oclc.org/oclc-service-configuration). Sign in, select *Metasearch Content*, and choose *Default Databases and Licensed Content*.
2. **Add the Cambridge University Press databases to which your library subscribes.** Click *Central Index Databases*, and search for *Cambridge*. Select the databases you subscribe to and click *Done*. Click *Save Changes* at the bottom of the page.

## Detailed guidance for selecting Cambridge University Press databases for searching in WorldCat Discovery

Follow the steps below to set up access to your Cambridge University Press subscription content through WorldCat Discovery. Because OCLC enhances WorldCat Discovery every month, the screen shots below may not match your view exactly. For the most up-to-date information, visit [oclc.org/database-config](https://oclc.org/oclc-service-configuration).

1. Sign in to [OCLC Service Configuration](https://oclc.org/oclc-service-configuration) site ([oclc.org/config](https://oclc.org/oclc-service-configuration)) by clicking *Use Your WorldCat Account* if you want to sign in with your WorldCat Account, or clicking *Use Your OCLC Services Account* if you want to sign in with your OCLC Services Account (WorldShare users).

- a. If this is your first time signing in using this method, you will be prompted to search for your institution. Enter your institution's OCLC symbol, name, or zip code.
  - b. Click *Continue* or press <Enter>.
2. Enter your username and password.
  3. Click *Sign In* or press <Enter>.

- a. If this is your first time signing in with your WorldCat Account, the *Select an Institution* dialog will appear. You can select an institution from the drop-down list or click *I am not affiliated with an institution* to access the WorldCat registry.
4. On the following page, select *Metasearch Content*, then *Default Databases and Licensed Content*. Click *Configure Databases to Search* to select databases to add.
  5. Click the *Central Index Databases* tab and use the search box to filter results.
  6. Select the databases to which you subscribe, and then click *Save*.

Central Index Databases rely on your subscriptions to third party vendor databases. Select the checkbox to enable the database for searching; you must also have an active subscription via a provider. Toggle the database status to display search results as held or not held by your institution.




By default, WorldCat Discovery searches all databases configured for searching. Use the steps below to filter results for the desired Cambridge University Press databases.

1. In WorldCat Discovery, click *Advanced Search*.
2. Click *All Databases* to display all the selected databases for your library.
3. Select the databases to include in your search filter.
4. Click *Save Changes*.
5. Perform your search. The selected databases appear in the search filters in the *Databases* section.
