




If you are having problems in accessing the new Stahl Online page on Cambridge Core; please follow the steps below.

Password must be at least 8 characters long, contain lower and upper case characters and not include the values **& = % <**.

Once entered, click the Save button, this will confirm that your password has been changed and you will be able to log using your new password.






