Advanced preview of the coursebook and digital resources



Units 1 & 2 will be ready to teach with from August 2025. To give you the chance to review the coursebook and evolving digital resources as early as possible, we are releasing the content and features in phases from April 25th, 2024.

The Phase 1 release in April will include....

- **NEW!** More accessible 6th edition Unit 1 & 2 digital coursebook, allowing students and teachers to add notes, embed links and highlights, and engage more deeply with the content.
- 'Explore the story' embedded in the digital coursebooks for Unit 1 & 2, making it easier to encourage learners to gain a deeper understanding of how the language works within the context of the stories. Word translations, derivations, and think questions can be accessed directly from the digital coursebook. Audio to come.
- **NEW!** Ability to assign vocabulary and translation activities from Unit 1 to students. These will give students instant feedback on their performance. Initially it will be a score at the end of the assignment which is stored on the student dashboard.
- **NEW!** Reports on student and class performance in a test so teachers can monitor student engagement and mastery. In our first release, teachers will be able to run reports for each test to show student results by question or by student. Initially, question level reporting will only be for single response MCQs, and student level reporting will be for all single response questions.
- **Accessibility:** Developed to support all our learners, we are working towards the WCAG 2.1 AA standard for our April 2024 launch of Units 1 and 2 with ongoing efforts to continue to improve.

Features to look forward to in subsequent releases!

We will be building, testing and releasing the following features and functionality over the summer.

- **NEW!** Audio for 'Explore the story' embedded within every stage in the Unit 1 digital coursebook, to aid pronunciation. There will be at least two audio tracks per stage by August, with more to come.
- **NEW!** Vocabulary, Reviewing the Language and sorting activities for both Units can be assigned by teachers to their classes. These will give students instant feedback on their performance. The exact nature of this feedback will be determined over the next few months. With the flexibility to set end dates or manually close assessments, teachers can control when the activities are taken.
- **NEW!** Additional reporting functionality, including for sorting questions, plus insights to help teachers identify and address areas in which the class and/or individuals are struggling.
- **NEW!** Single sign-on with Canvas, so that students have seamless access to the material and don't need to remember multiple passwords.
