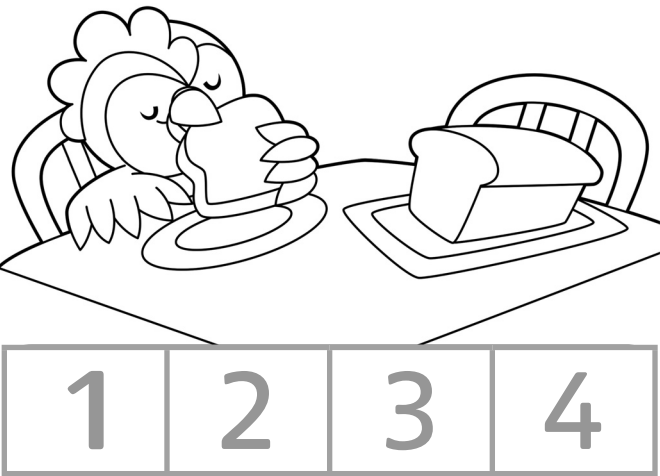
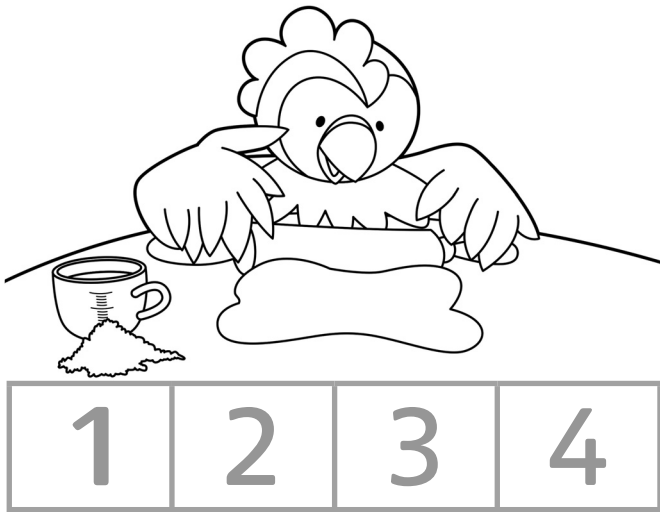
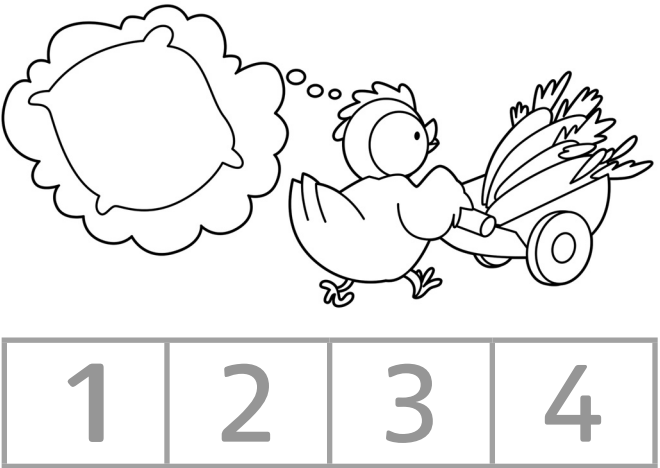
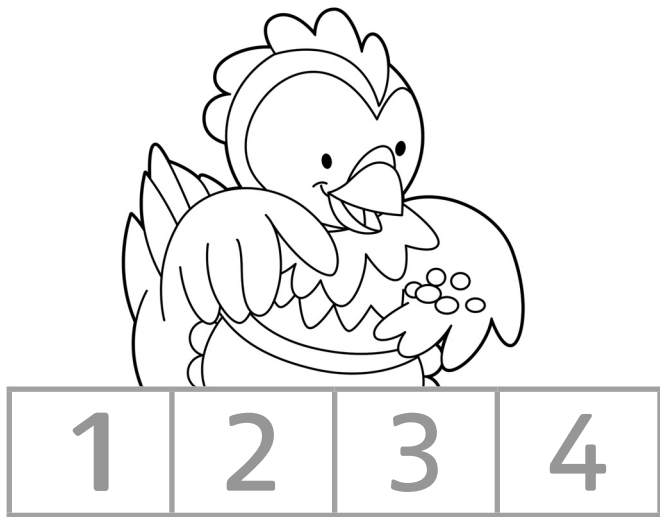
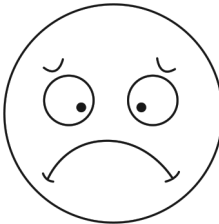


 **Point.**  **Circle.**  **Color.**



Do you like the story?



Key Language: *What happens first? What happens next? What happens at the end?* Ask children to remember the story and say: *What happens first?* Point to the first picture and retell together. Children trace or circle number 1. Then say: *What happens next?* pointing to the next picture, retelling together and tracing or circling number 2. Continue with the third and fourth picture and numbers. Finally, ask: *Do you like the story?* (Yes. / No.) Children color the happy face or the sad face.

 **Point.**  **Say.**  **Draw.**



Key Language: What comes next? Children look at each row of animals. They point and say the name of each animal in the row. Guide the children to notice the pattern. Ask: *What comes next?* and help them with the responses by repeating the pattern, e.g., *Duck, cow, duck, cow, duck ... What comes next?* Then they draw the animal that completes the sequence.
