Every day from 6 a.m. to 1 a.m.

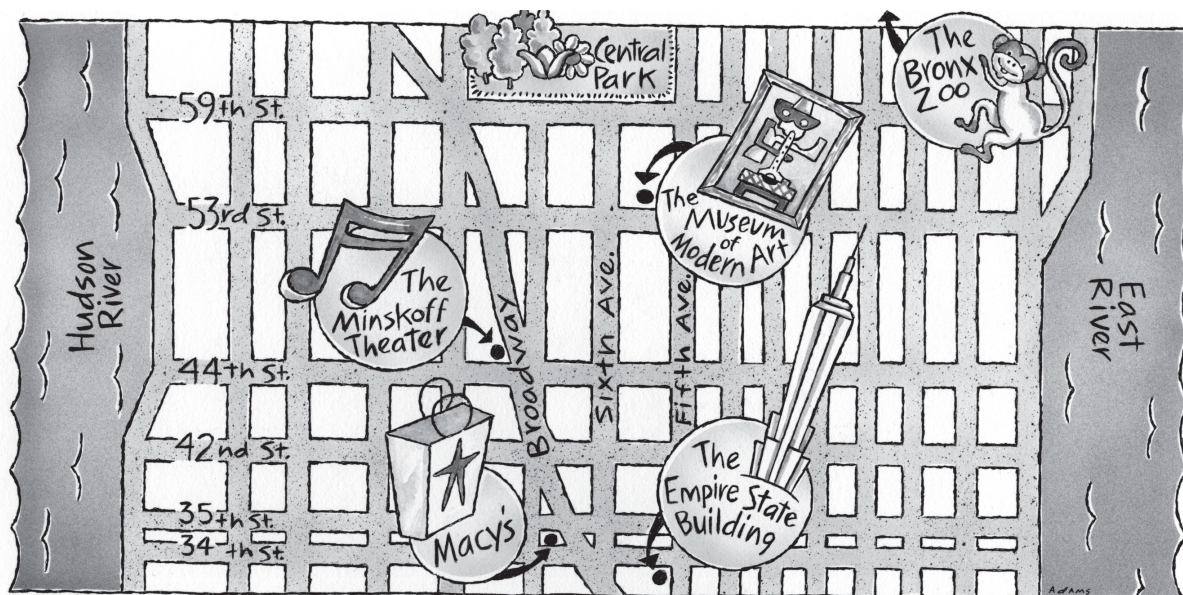

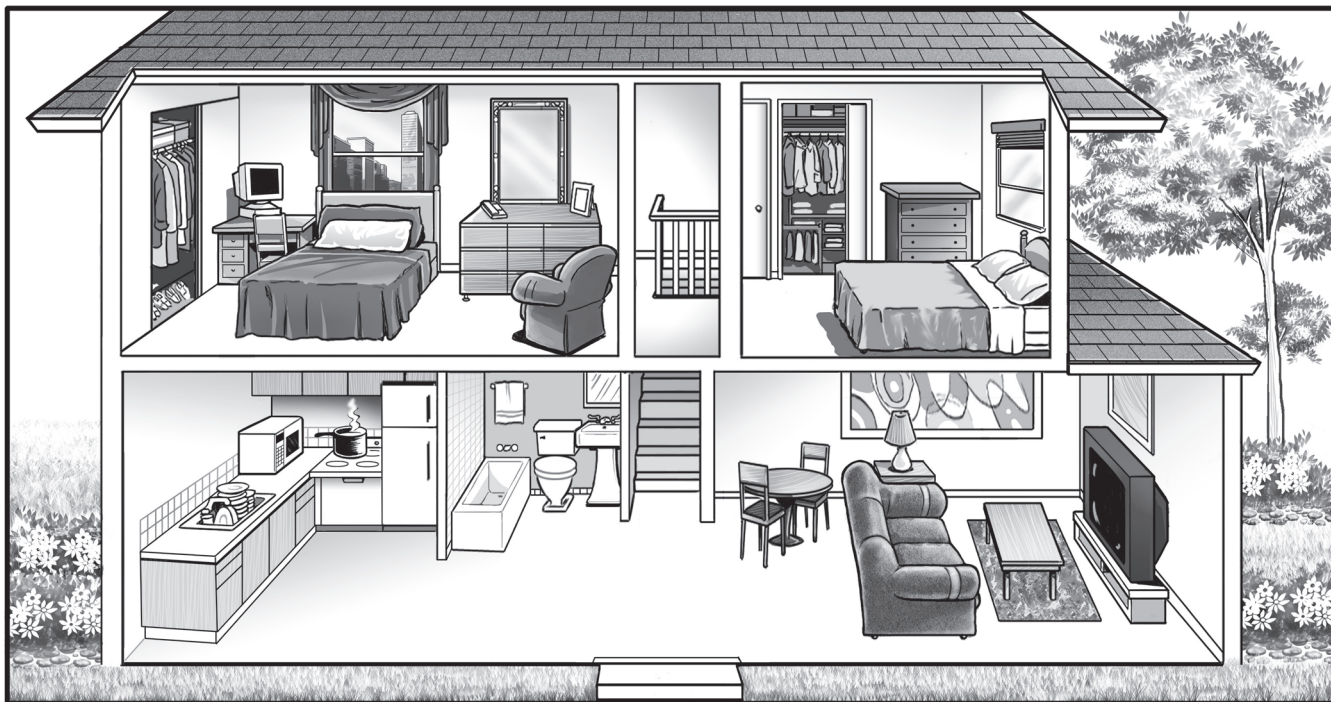

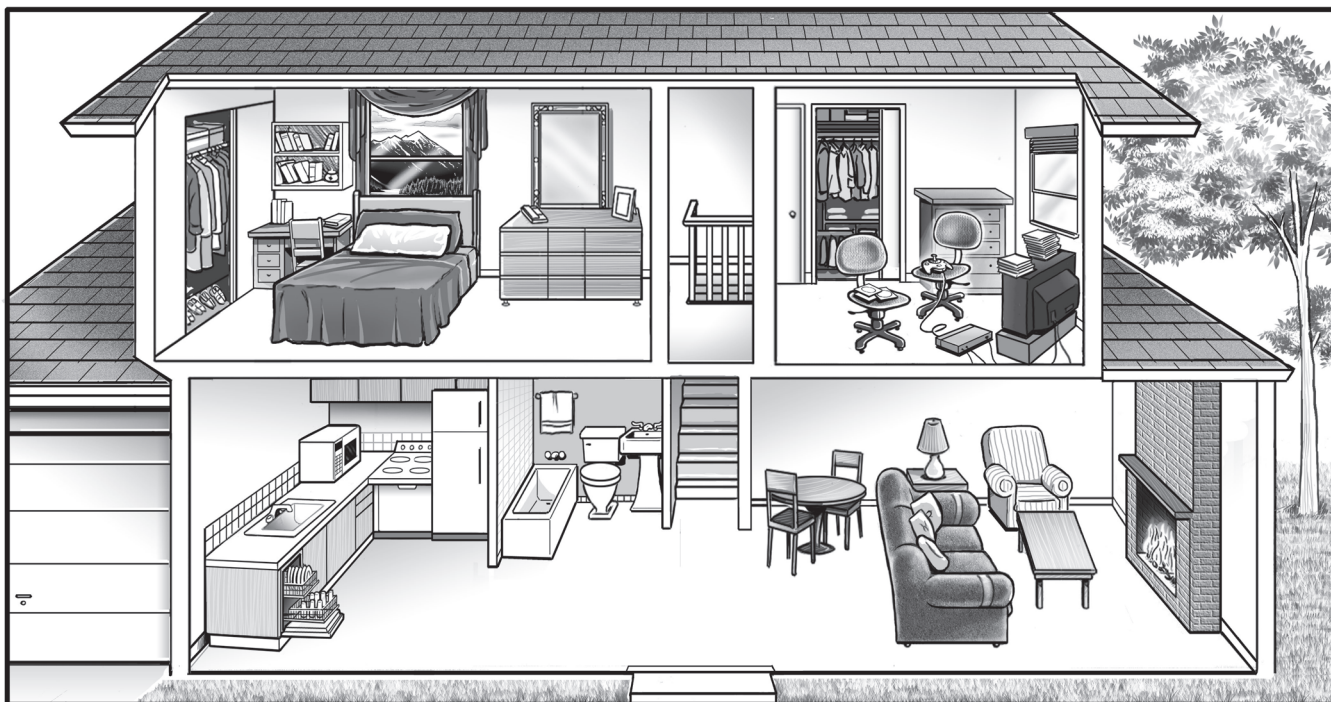
