

THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO
ST JOHN

1 In the beginning ^awas the Word, and the Word was ^bwith God, ^cand the Word was God.

2 ^dThe same was in the beginning with God.

3 ^eAll things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.

4 ^fIn him was life; and ^gthe life was the light of men.

5 And ^hthe light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.

6 ⁱThere was a man sent from God, whose name was John.

7 ^jThe same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all *men* through him might believe.

8 He was not that Light, but was sent to bear witness of that Light.

9 ^kThat was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.

10 He was in the world, and ^lthe world was made by him, and the world knew him not.

11 ^mHe came unto his own, and his own received him not.

12 But ⁿas many as received him, to them gave he ^opower to become the sons of God, *even* to them that believe on his name:

13 ^pwhich were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

14 ^qAnd the Word ^rwas made ^sflesh, and dwelt among us, (and ^twe beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) ^ufull of grace and truth.

15 ^vJohn bare witness of him, and cried, saying, This was he of whom I spake, ^wHe that cometh after me is preferred before me: ^xfor he was before me.

16 And of his ^yfulness have all we received, and grace for grace.

17 For ^zthe law was given by Moses, but ^{aa}grace and ^{ab}truth came by Jesus Christ.

18 ^{ac}No man hath seen God at any time; ^{ad}the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared *him*.

19 And this is ^{ae}the record of John, when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, Who art thou?

20 And ^{af}he confessed, and denied not; but confessed, I am not the Christ.

21 And they asked him, What then? Art thou ^{ag}Elias? And he saith, I am not. Art thou ^{ah}that prophet? And he answered, No.

22 Then said they unto him, Who art thou? that we may give an answer to them that sent us. What sayest thou of thyself?

23 ^{ai}He said, I *am* the voice of one crying in the wilderness, Make straight the way of the Lord, as ^{aj}said the prophet Esaias.

24 And they which were sent were of the Pharisees.

25 And they asked him, and said unto him, Why baptizest thou then, if thou be not that Christ, nor Elias, neither that prophet?

26 John answered them, saying, ^{ak}I baptize with water: ^{al}but there standeth one among you, whom ye know not;

27 ^{am}he it is, who coming after me is preferred before me, whose shoe's latchet I am not worthy to unloose.

28 These things were done ^{an}in Bethabara beyond Jordan, where John was baptizing.

29 The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold ^{ao}the Lamb of God, ^{ap}which ^{aq}taketh away the sin of the world.
