- ⁵ And ^hthe light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.
- ⁶ There was a man sent from God, whose name was John.
- ⁷ The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all men through him might believe.
- 8 He was not that Light, but was sent to bear witness of that Light.
- lighteth every man that cometh into the world.
- 10 He was in the world, and 'the world was made by him, and the world knew him not.
- ¹¹ ^mHe came unto his own, and his own received him not.
- 12 But "as many as received him, to them gave he 'power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:
- 13 °which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.
- 14 PAnd the Word Pwas made 'flesh, and dwelt among us, (and 's we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) ^tfull of grace and truth.
- ¹⁵ John bare witness of him, and cried, saying, This was he of whom I spake, 'He that cometh after me is preferred before me: "for he was before me.
- 16 And of his *fulness have all we received, and grace for grace.

- ¹⁷ For ^ythe law was given by Moses, but zgrace and atruth came by Jesus Christ.
- 18 ab No man hath seen God at any time; acthe only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father. he hath declared him.
- 19 And this is ^{ad}the record of John, when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, Who art thou?
- 20 And aehe confessed, and denied not: but confessed. I am not the Christ.
- 21 And they asked him, What then? Art thou ^{af}Elias? And he saith, I am not. Art thou ag2that prophet? And he answered, No.
- ²² Then said they unto him, Who art thou? that we may give an an-^{9 h}That was the true Light, which swer to them that sent us. What sayest thou of thyself?
 - ²³ ^{ah}He said, I am the voice of one crying in the wilderness, Make straight the way of the Lord, as aisaid the prophet Esaias.
 - 24 And they which were sent were of the Pharisees.
 - 25 And they asked him, and said unto him, Why baptizest thou then, if thou be not that Christ, nor Elias, neither that prophet?
 - ²⁶ John answered them, saying, ^{aj}I baptize with water: ^{ah}but there standeth one among you, whom ye know not;
 - ²⁷ ^{al}he it is, who coming after me is preferred before me, whose shoe's latchet I am not worthy to unloose.
 - 28 These things were done amin Bethabara beyond Jordan, where John was baptizing.
 - 29 The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold anthe Lamb of God, aowhich staketh away the sin of the world.
