



New Revised Standard Version Apocrypha/ Deuterocanonical Books

The New Revised Standard Version Apocrypha include all the texts accepted as deuterocanonical by the Eastern Orthodox Churches as well as by Roman Catholics and Protestants. There are four groupings:

A Books and Additions to Esther and Daniel that are in the Roman Catholic, Greek and Slavonic Bibles

Tobit

Judith

The Additions to the Book of Esther (with a translation of the entire Greek text of Esther)

Wisdom of Solomon

Ecclesiasticus, or the Wisdom of Jesus Son of Sirach

Baruch

The Letter of Jeremiah (=Baruch ch 6)

The Additions to the Book of Daniel

 The Prayer of Azariah and the Song of the Three Jews

 Susanna

 Bel and the Dragon

I Maccabees

II Maccabees

B Books in the Greek and Slavonic Bibles; not in the Roman Catholic Canon

I Esdras (-II Esdras in Slavonic – III Esdras in Vulgate Appendix)

Prayer of Manasseh (in Appendix to Vulgate)

Psalm 151, following Psalm 150 in the Greek Bible

III Maccabees

C In the Slavonic Bible and in the Appendix to the Latin Vulgate

II Esdras (= III Esdras in Slavonic = IV Esdras in Appendix to Vulgate)

(Note: In the Latin Vulgate, Ezra-Nehemiah = I and II Esdras)

D In an Appendix to the Greek Bible

IV Maccabees
