The Editorial Board wishes to congratulate Richard G. Heck, Jr., the winner of the Journal's first annual Essay Prize. Each year the prize, worth \$1000, will be awarded to the article voted best overall by the Editorial Board. Heck's article, 'Frege on Identity and Identity-Statements: A Reply to Thau and Caplan,' accepted for publication in 2002, appeared in the March issue of 2003.

In 2002, the Journal received 205 new submissions. By May 14, 2003, 17 of these submissions had been accepted for publication, while another 13 still remained undecided. 17/192 yields an acceptance rate for 2002 of 8.85%.
